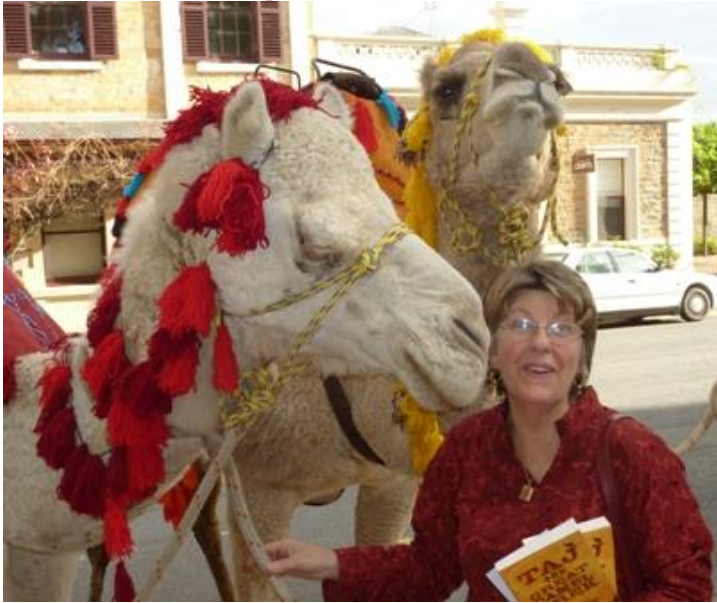


## ***Camels at Kapunda***
